Tuesday, 29.09.2020 Introduction

Episode 1 will provide an overview of the webinar series and a tool to help identify which of the following webinars are applicable and valuable to your country's specific situation and needs.

Thursday, 08.10.2020 Focus on: Club Players

Episode 2 will focus on club players, offering best practices and recommendations for how to improve data quality, get more players registered, and use digital initiatives to build relationships with more players. You will learn about the value to NA both in growing participation and the potential to grow commercial revenue.

Tuesday, 13.10.2020 Focus on: Non-Club Players

Episode 3 will focus on current players who do not play in traditional clubs, for example those who play in commercial leagues. The episode will use case studies from NAs who have successfully grown participation in this area, and will help you understand the potential opportunity for your NA.

Wednesday, 21.10.2020 Don't Play Football- Connected to Players

Episode 4 will discuss another important group in the football family – those who don't currently football play but have a connection to amateur players. This might be friends or family of club and non-club players. This episode will show how NAs have worked successfully to engage these people, to increase the participation of those around them and even get them into playing themselves.

Tuesday, 27.10.2020 Don't Play Football – (latent) Interest in Playing Football

Episode 5 will talk about another big group of potential players – those who don't currently play but might like to do so. In this session we will discuss the potential offers for introducing new players to the game and getting former players back into playing. This episode will also contain a recap and summary of the whole series.
